WELCOME TO THE TEAM!

Expectations:

- Citizenship Grade of “E” at all times. If not then you are removed from the team from duty for one month.
- Must turn in all assignments on time. Failure to complete classroom assignments will result in removal from duty for one month.
- **Attendance** – Cannot be a Patrol if you are not here.
 - 3 unexcused absences will result in removal from the team
- **Punctuality** – We need you here on time ready to go to your spots
 - 7:10 a.m. Morning Duty
 - 2:50 p.m. Afternoon Duty
 - Constant tardiness will be handled on an individual basis.

3 B’s

- **Be Here**
- **Be SAFE**
- **Be Courteous**

Remember:

You are always a Safety Patrol; in class, rotation, library, lunch, etc. Be a leader at all times.

Responsibilities

- Come to the gym and sign in. Check what area you will be covering.
- Pick up your belt and put it on and wait quietly on the black line.

Student Drop-off (Afternoon)

- Stay on the curb
- Open car door and say, “Good Morning, Have a nice day”

Student Pick-up (Afternoon Duty)

- Listen to Mrs. Feldt to see who is coming to the letter to be placed in the car.
- Find the student and put him/her in the car and say, ‘Don’t forget to buckle up’ and “Have a good night”

Flags (Never let them touch the ground)

1. Raising

Pick up from the coaches office

The American Flag goes up first

The Texas Flag goes second. White part of the Flag goes up

2. Lowering

Little or no talking

Fold in Triangle shape and put away in the coaches office

If flags are wet, lay them flat on the equipment carts in the gym closets.

Cafeteria (Morning duty)

Walk around the cafeteria and help students, custodians, & teachers.

Stairwell (Morning/ Afternoon Duty)

Monitor stairs to make sure students are walking safely.

Assist teachers who may need help

Main doorway (Morning/ Afternoon Duty)

Greet visitors and open doors to allow students, parents, teachers, and visitors to come in/out.

Cross Walk (Morning/ Afternoon Duty)

Help people cross to our school (listen to adult crosswalk guard)

- Signs in (Hold sign at your side)
- Signs out (Hold sign in front of you, facing the traffic)

Hallways (Morning/ Afternoon Duty)

Walk around and monitor students

- If we have stickers, pass out the stickers to students.
- Read to the younger students.
