

HOLD! In your room or area. Clear the halls.

ADULTS

Clear the hallways and remain Close and lock door Account for students and adults Clear" is announced



Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS

ADULTS Return to inside of building Bring everyone indoors Do business as usual Lock outside doors Increase situational awareness Account for students and adults Do business as usual



LOCKDOWN! Locks, lights, out of sight. STUDENTS **ADULTS**

Move away from sight Do not open the door

Recover students from hallway if possible Lock the classroom door Turn out the lights Move away from sight

Do not open the door Prepare to evade or defend



EVACUATE! (A location may be specified) **ADULTS**

Leave stuff behind if required to If possible, bring your phone Follow instructions

Attendance

- Attendance is IMPORTANT, we want you here
 :-)
- Class starts at 7:45! This does not mean that we are walking in the door at 7:45.
- Early outs... please limit them to absolute necessities. Please contact administration with any questions.
- 90% is still the expectation and will be monitored daily.





Texas Compulsory Attendance Law

Students must attend class 90% of the school year



Unexcused & Excused Absences

ALL absences count! Students who have more than 17 total absences are at risk of not being promoted, Parent/Guardians may also be issued a municipal court warning and possibly pay a fine.



Medical Appointments

Appointments must be at the **start** or **end** of the school day to be counted as **HEALTH** and not as an absence. If the student is out the **entire day**, they are absent.



Why do I need to send a note?

If a student's attendance case is sent to court, a committee will take into consideration how many absences were excused and unexcused.



Tardies

Students who arrive after 9am are considered ABSENT. This does not mean your child should stay home. Staying home will make your student fall behind by missing an entire day of instruction.



If your child is ill and will be out of school for **more than 1 day**, please inform your child's classroom teacher. They should be your first line of communication.



Every student's situation is different. If there are barriers keeping your student from being at school, reach out to your campus. There are resources and people to help.

- Be patient with yourselves and your teacher.


HAC-page 2




