The goal of the Summer Reading Program is to engage **ALL** students in rigorous, high-interest novels (chapter books) of THEIR choice. Throughout the summer, students will actively read a novel (or many) and participate in a reading/writing connection activity within the first grading period. **All students are highly encouraged to participate in reading this summer as it is the goal for all students to become better readers.**

Summer Reading is Required For all ELA pre-AP students. While pre-AP students may read graphic novels for pleasure, <u>no graphic novels</u> may be used for the Pre-AP fall project.

1. Select a novel or non-fiction book of your choice on grade level from your home, public library, online, or at your local bookstore! 2. Keep notes of title, author, character, setting, etc.

You MAY NOT select a picture book (which, unlike a graphic novel, is very short and usually meant for young children), a book that you have read, or a book that was taught in your previous ELA classes. Summer reading novels need to be read by the end of August 2020.

Novel Choices: We have developed a list of suggested authors and popular novels you can choose from. Don't forget to ask family members, friends, and teachers for suggestions. These lists are meant as resources to help you get started on your search for great books. You may choose a book that is not on any of these lists.
