WELCOME TO THE TEAM!

Expectations:

- Citizenship Grade of “E” at all times. If not then you are removed from the team.
- If you receive an office referral, you will be removed from the safety patrol team.
- Patrols **MUST** turn in all assignments on time. Failure to complete classroom assignments will result in removal from the safety patrol team.
- **Attendance** – Cannot be a Patrol if you are not here.
 - 5 unexcused absences will result in removal from the team
 - 5 late drop offs(am)/ pickups (pm) will result in removal from the team.
- **Punctuality** – We need you here on time ready to go to your spots
 - 7:10 a.m. Morning Duty
 - 2:55 p.m. Afternoon Duty
 - Constant tardiness will be handled on an individual basis.

3 B's

- **Be Here**
- **Be SAFE**
- **Be Courteous**

Remember:

You are always a Safety Patrol; in class, rotation, library, lunch, etc. Be a leader at all times. Lead by example....

Responsibilities (Both)

- Come to the gym and sign in. Check what area you will be covering.
- Pick up your belt and put it on and wait quietly on the black line.

Flags - NEVER let the flags touch the ground (Both)

1. Raising

Pick up in the coaches office

The American Flag goes up first

The Texas Flag goes second. White part of the Flag goes up (clouds).

2. Lowering

Little or no talking

Fold in Triangle shape and put away in the coaches office.

If flags are wet, lay them flat in the tables in the lounge

Student Drop-off (Morning)

- Stay on the curb
- Open the car door and say, “Good Morning, Have a nice day,” close the car door gently.

Foyer (Morning Duty)

Monitor stairs to make sure students are walking safely.

Assist teachers who may need help.

Greet students as they enter or are coming up the stairs.

Hallway - gym area (Morning duty)

Monitor & direct students in the morning.

Cafeteria (Morning Duty)

Walk around the cafeteria and help students get seated and help out in the cafeteria.

Main doorway (Both)

Greet visitors and open doors to allow students, parents, teachers, and visitors to come in/out.


Cross Walk (Both)

Help people cross to our school

- Signs in (Hold sign at your side)
- Signs out (Hold sign in front of you, facing the traffic)

Student Pick-up (Afternoon)

- Ask the parent/guardian who they are picking up and put their child in the car.
- Find the student and put him/her in the car and say, "Have a good night/ weekend, see you tomorrow," close the car door gently.
