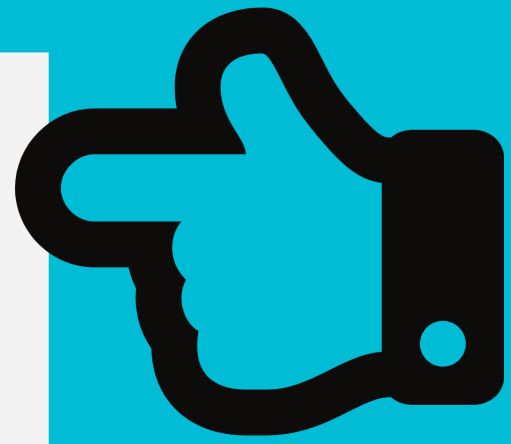


DOs and DON'Ts Of Zoom Meetings at home

Here are a few things you can do to ensure your child is safe while on a Zoom meeting at home.



Do

Join a meeting by clicking the link in your child's schoology course.

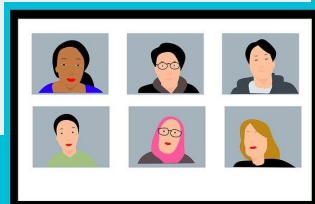
Rather than downloading and installing the Zoom app, you can increase your security by using the web interface to access your class

Show your child how to enter their name before joining a meeting.

Names will be used to take attendance.

Keep a meeting space consistent in your home

Be aware of background noise



Don't

Share the meeting link and password on any social media platform.

Allow your child to use nicknames as their username in Zoom.

Refrain from having personal photos, addresses, or other *personal items in the background.*
Don't take your class on a field trip of your home during class, stay in a designated area to avoid distraction.

Have TV shows or conversations in the background with inappropriate language or content.

-Don't say inappropriate things during class, remember you are in school
